

### **March Town Meeting – March 9, 2010**

Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Terry Schultz.

All board members were present.

The agenda was approved with a motion by Jean Dehn, seconded by Terry Schultz. Motion carried.

The minutes of the February town board meeting were read and approved with a motion by Schultz, seconded by Dehn. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report was reviewed. National Forest Sales are \$60,019.50 this year.

Schultz said the truck will be ready next week. Schultz showed the board examples of stickers for the truck. Schultz made a motion, seconded by Anthony Kiselicka, to go with Design Cut Signs for the stickers for the truck. Motion carried. Schultz stated the flaps which come down the sides of the truck will be sixty dollars extra. Schultz made a motion, seconded by Dehn, to purchase the manual tarp for \$659.00 and the flaps for \$60.00, for a total of \$719.00. Motion carried.

The comprehensive plan was discussed.

The beaver dam causing flooding on Winter Sports Road was discussed. It was decided to write a letter to Clare's concerning the damage the beaver are causing.

General bills 1495 thru 1497 were reviewed and approved with a motion by Schultz, seconded by Kiselicka. Motion carried.

Highway bills 1512 thru 1519 and 1521 were reviewed and approved with a motion by Dehn, seconded by Kiselicka. Motion carried.

A review for the grader operator was held. Holly thanked the grader operator for the timely submitting of the snow-plowing bills. A motion was made by Schultz, seconded by Kiselicka, to give the grader operator a one dollar an hour raise. Dehn abstained from voting. Motion carried.

Schultz will put the bids for gravel and culverts/ditching in the newspaper.

A motion was made to adjourn by Dehn, seconded by Schultz. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:13 p.m.
